

How does Replai work?

Replai in no way takes over the stream, retransmits, rebroadcasts, broadcasts or distributes the radio stream and doesn't store any audio content. Replai is also not a hosting service.

The "Replai Radio" application is a specialized internet browser with a built-in powerful player (player) of audio content (radio stations, podcasts and others), publicly available on the Internet (also around the world), at a specific URL (hyperlink).

Replai works much like a typical web browser - the difference between a standard browser and the Replai browser is the fact that it is a specialized browser that allows you to conveniently play audio content (e.g. improve sound quality through the use of an equalizer) available at specific Internet public URLs. Like a typical web browser, it allows you to browse websites and add them to the list of favorites in order to quickly and conveniently reach your favorite content, while its distinguishing feature is making it easier to listen to audio content contained on publicly available websites.

If your website is available in your country, Replai, like other web browsers, will be able to display and play the content you place on it.

In each case, the display of the website and the playback of audio content takes place at the request of the user of the application (user action) by playing the audio content available at the URL belonging to and under the full and exclusive control of the owner of the website and, if applicable, the owner of the relevant web server (service provider for the owner of the website).

Replai cannot influence the content available at certain Internet URLs. The Replai browser, at the user's request, establishes a connection between the user's device and the audio content available at a specific URL (on the website of a specific sender) on the Internet. The user can always display and browse the website directly in the Replai browser (the "www" button on the favicon of the station and the corresponding item in the menu).

The website address is always displayed (as with any other typical web browser) in the bar at the top of the screen when the browser window is maximized.

URL directory

The Replai user has the ability to enter a web URL address himself (as in the case of other web browsers), and then view and listen to audio content available at the URL entered by him.

Additionally, publicly available URLs can be added to the Replai directory by application users and by our bot (user-agent: Replaiobot).

Graphic identification

The logo of an internet station is usually the so-called ico of the website (accessible to the public at the specified URL). Its display may be subject to standard cache mechanisms. If you want to send us a different file with your logo, please contact us at support@repla.io.

I am the sender of content available at a specific URL and I do not want my URLs to be in the Replaio directory and I do not want Replaio users to be able to listen to audio content broadcast on my websites

We recommend that you contact us directly before making a decision. We assure you that Replaio users will want to listen to content in our browser, and we offer various additional options for you that you may be interested in.

If you do not want Replaio users to be able to browse your website and listen to the audio content you broadcast on it, you have 3 options.

Choose the most convenient form for you.

1. Due to the fact that Replaio does not transmit or retransmit the audio content you broadcast, but only establishes a connection between the Replaio web browser and your server, the entire transmission is always and in any case managed exclusively by you. All you have to do is change the status from publicly available URL to authenticated and your content will no longer be immediately available in the Replaio browser. Our participation is not required to perform this option.

Note: if you want to remove content from other places on the Internet - contact us, we provide a wide range of services for broadcasters of content on the Internet.

2. (Alternative option) Please send a list of URLs you wish to block to support@repla.io.

All URLs sent by you will be added by us (maximum within 1 business day) to the list of blocked URLs and from then until you delete them, they cannot be added by users to the directory, favorites list and will not be indexed by our bots.

3. (Alternative option) Use standard bot blocking mechanisms for web browsers, i.e. by properly configuring the robots.txt file
